Spring Leagues

Each team will shoot 10 weeks at the 16 yard line and 10 weeks at the 20 yard line. The League will be divided into classes after the 4th week of shooting and teams will compete against teams in their class to determine the class winner at the end of the season.

Wednesday Night Trap – Secretary Fred Olson & Al Eggerichs

The league will shoot for 20 weeks. Warm up is March 30th and shooting for score begins April 6th. The league ends on August 17th and the banquet will be August 24th. Teams will shoot against all other teams in the league per a posted schedule. Each shooter on the team will be given a handicap determined by their average.
