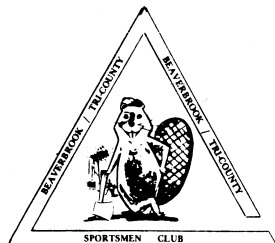
Prorated Payment Option:

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Thank you for expressing an interest in Beaverbrook Sportsmen's Club membership. A Beaverbrook membership allows the member the following benefits.

1. Trap and Skeet shooting at reduced membership rates.
2. Use of the trap fields for hand thrown traps, only when the clubhouse is closed.
3. Use of the rifle or pistol range for a \$1.00 per member visit fee. The ranges are closed to all nonmembers although members are allowed to bring a maximum of **two** guests per visit to use the rifle or pistol range. All guests must be personally supervised by the member and pay a \$5.00 per person visit fee.
4. Use of the archery range.
5. Use of the grounds for dog training.

The first step in becoming a Beaverbrook member is to fill out an application and return it, with a check made out to Beaverbrook, to the address listed below. Beaverbrook has a limited membership. After submitting an application and paying the membership and initiation fees, applicants must be approved by the Beaverbrook Board of Directors before they actually become a member. Applicants who have not been referred for membership by a current member must attend the next Board Meeting when their application is reviewed. Board Meetings are held the third Wednesday of each month, for meeting times please see our web page. Also with the first order of business being the review of applications, please be prompt.

The current yearly membership fee for general members is \$130.00; new general members are also required to pay a \$40.00 initiation fee, for a total of \$170.00. Members can obtain a \$55.00 credit to be applied to the next year's membership fee by working a minimum of 10 verified hours during the year. The yearly membership fee for associate members (minor child of a member) is \$5.00; new associate members are also required to pay a \$2.00 initiation fee, for a total of \$7.00. Also for individuals joining during the second half of the year we do offer a prorated option allowing prospective members to save on membership fees for the partial year.

Any applicant that is not approved for membership will be refunded any money they have paid for membership and initiation fees.

General Safety and Range Rules

Beaverbrook Tri-County Sportsmen's Club

SAFETY is the most important aspect of shooting! There is an internationally accepted safe way to shoot trap and skeet. Just as in all other sports, these procedures or rules must be followed. There has never been a serious accident in trap shooting history. Let's make certain we don't break that record.

GENERAL SAFETY RULES

- **ALWAYS** keep your gun pointed in a safe direction, **NEVER** at anyone.
- Treat every gun as if it was loaded.
- **ALWAYS** check your chamber and have your gun with the chamber **OPEN** when standing in a gun rack.
- **ALWAYS** check the chamber each time you pick up a gun.
- **NEVER** carry your gun over your shoulder with the barrel pointing **BEHIND** you.

SAFETY ON THE FIRING LINE

- Pullers/Scorers on the field will have **FULL** authority.
- **ALWAYS** keep your gun pointed down range.
- **ALWAYS** when entering or leaving the firing line check your chamber, your gun **MUST** be open and unloaded.
- **NEVER** turn around while shooting, as after loss or a misfire, etc.
- Do not pick up empty hulls
- **NEVER** point or swing guns or begin shooting if the puller has the safety flag/cone up.
- **NO** alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the shooting fields.

SAFETY ON THE TRAP FIELD

- **NEVER** load more than one shell, unless shooting Doubles.
- **NEVER** load your gun and/or close the action until it is your turn to shoot.
- **NEVER** turn around while shooting or point gun over your shoulder. Guns **MUST** always point toward the trap house.
- **ALWAYS** turn to the right when moving from station 5 to station 1 and walk behind your squad. Be absolutely sure your gun is unloaded and pointed straight **UP**.
- **DO NOT** point guns at the trap house or begin shooting if the puller has the safety flag/cone up.

SAFETY ON THE SKEET FIELD

- **ALWAYS** point your gun down range.
- **NEVER** load more than two shells at a time.
- **NEVER** close the action of your gun until you are on the station and it is your turn to shoot.
- **ALWAYS** check your gun when leaving the station. Make sure your gun is open and unloaded.
- **NEVER** turn around while you are shooting. Know where your gun barrel is pointed.

RIFLE & PISTOL RANGE SAFETY RULES

- **NO** alcohol permitted.
- During cease fire, all firearms must be cleared, actions open, not handled and shooters must step clear the firing line.
- Use only target stands and paper targets. **NO** cans or bottles. Shoot only from the shooting line within the range boundaries. Use target stands that ensure all rounds must hit the backstop immediately behind the target.
- Each shooter must verify range is clear before firing.
- Full automatic firearms prohibited.
- Shooting hours: **NOT** before 9:00 a.m., **NOT** after the earlier of 9:00 p.m. or Dusk
